### NELIGH RECYCLING

**Public Hours of Compactor/Transfer Station located 1 mile south and ½ mile west of Neligh:**

**Tuesday's & Thursday's from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

**Saturday's from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

**City-Wide Recycling Pickup: Please have recycling at the curb by 8:00 a.m. of your appropriate Thursday.**

**EAST side of town (from Hwy 275 or L St and East): First & Third Thursday of each month**

**WEST side of town (from Hwy 275 or L St and West): Second & Fourth Thursday of each month**

**If the month has a 5th Thursday, there is NO recycling pickup.**

**ALL ITEMS MUST BE SEPARATED FOR CURB SIDE PICKUP. Please keep papers & cardboard dry.**

#### GLASS

Items accepted include: glass food and beverage containers that may contain normal bottle labels and rings.

**ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:** windows, mirrors, light bulbs, pottery, porcelain, ceramics, Pyrex, Corning Ware.

#### PLASTIC CONTAINERS

All plastics #1-#7 will be picked up during curbside pickup at the regularly scheduled Thursday (depending on which side of the town residents live on). All items should be rinsed. Caps CAN NOT be left on containers. Examples of items accepted: milk jugs, juice containers, butter and yogurt tubs, pill bottles, ice cream buckets, cottage cheese, sour cream containers, etc.

Plastics must be sorted as follows:

- Plastic bottles #1 (Clear) – Soda, water, juice bottles
- Plastic bottles #2 (Natural/Colorless) – Milk jugs, etc.
- Plastic bottles #2 thru #7 (Colored) – Detergent, etc.

The following accepted items may be dropped off at the Compactor 1 mile south and ½ mile west of Neligh during normal working hours:

Additional Plastics:

- Auto bumpers/ fenders – all wiring, lights and metals must be removed
- Plastic banding/strapping – banding of all color and sizes, can be whole or cut
- Plastic drain tiling – all lengths and diameters, dirt must be removed.
- Plastic Pails/Buckets – buckets of all sizes, No metal. Must be rinsed of all chemicals
- PVC pipe – pipe of all colors and sizes accepted. New and used pipe accepted.
- Vinyl siding – siding without metal or paper attached.
- Baled plastic wrap – plastic wrap of all colors. (*however, hay bales plastic is not recyclable & must be put in trash*)
- Plastic rolls – all sizes and colors.
- Plastic barrels/drums – assorted sizes and colors – must be **triple** rinsed.
- 5-gallon barrels – labels and lids are ok, must be **triple** rinsed.
- Plastic Bulk Containers – metal cages are OK, must be **triple** rinsed.
- Plastic Pipe – post and pre-consumer pipes all colors and sizes.
- Plastic pallets – can be whole or damaged.
- Plastic containers – any plastic container whole or damaged.

\*\*\*Please note that Lumber wrap – woven PP, not Tyvek is not recyclable and should be placed in the trash.

\*\*\*Please note that water softener bags are not recyclable should be placed in the trash.

### ALUMINUM CANS

Beverage cans such as pop and beer are accepted. Empty beverage cans. No aluminum foils. Current price is \$.20/lb.

*\*\*\*Please note pet food cans are not recyclable aluminum and should be placed in the trash.*

### TIN CANS/ITEMS

Rinse cans and remove labels and lids on are ok.

### PAPER & NEWSPAPER

If it comes in the newspaper, it can STAY in the newspaper. No more sorting. All the following items can be put TOGETHER: newspaper (and inserts), magazines, white and colored paper, junk mail (slick postcards too), envelopes, catalogs, grocery ads and phone books (without covers). The entire Norfolk shopper can be placed in this pile – but please remove the plastic bag it is delivered in.

*\*\*\*Please note that phone book covers go with cardboard. Christmas wrapping paper should be placed in trash.*

### SHREDDED OFFICE PAPER

Place all shredded office paper in a plastic bag.

### CARDBOARD

Items accepted include corrugated cardboard, brown grocery sacks, toy boxes, pop and beer container boxes, detergent boxes, cracker and cereal boxes. Flatten all items.

*\*\*\*Please note we do not take cardboard with a wax coating (example: milk or juice cartons).*

### BATTERIES

Car or truck batteries are accepted and paid for at \$.50 per battery.

### ELECTRONICS

The following electronic items are recyclable at the Compactor during normal business hours:

Computers, Networking Equipment, Keyboards, Battery Backups, Power Supplies, Routers, Surge Protectors, Monitors (flat screen only), printers, laptops, any type of cords, Cell phones, Modems, Memory Sticks, CD Players, Old Boombox radios, Hard drives, servers, Televisions (flat screens, all sizes & old TV's up to 27 "), VCR/DVD/VHS players

Businesses that accumulate cardboard, please contact the city office to discuss cardboard collection.

### **ITEMS NOT ALLOWED FOR RECYCLING**

#4 bags (water softener), herbicide jugs, Christmas paper, milk or juice cartons (cardboard with wax coating.)

NO STYROFOAM PRODUCTS, DIAPERS, TIRES, FOOD, OIL or OIL CONTAINERS.
